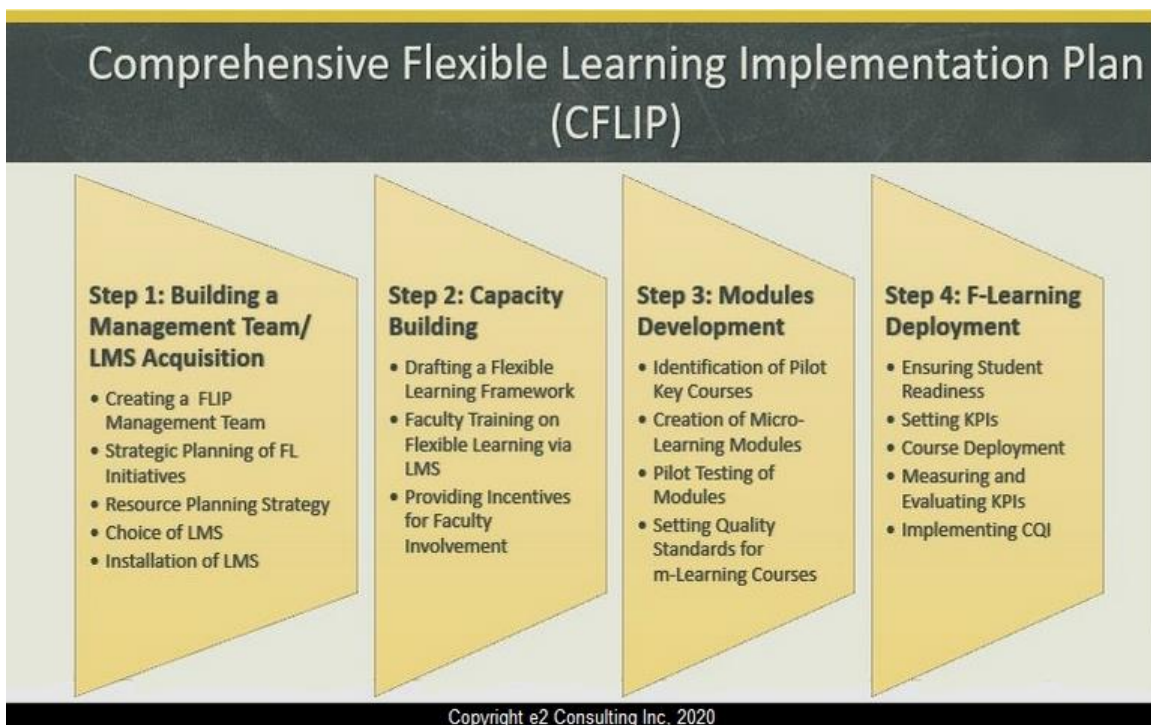


## INVITATION TO FLEXIBLE LEARNING IMPLEMENTATION COURSES
